The Festival of Vallée d'Olt will hold its 17th edition of culture and music in the charming countryside of France. It includes a chamber music concert series during the second half of July on the upper valley of the Lot River.

Each year, our faculty features soloists from the renowned Opéra Bastille including Laurent Lefèvre, Jacques Tys and CélineNessi, the festival's artistic director.

Here, one is able to embark on new discoveries while exploring an eclectic range of chamber music repertoire.

The Festival boasts a long tradition of outstanding quality combined with a strong sense of community from the musicians who gather together for this special event.

The Academy takes place in the heart of Saint-Geniez, where different halls are made available for the festival.

All the teachers are chosen based on their musical abilities as well as their personal rapport with the students. As the student's best interests are held in the highest priority, only a limited number of applicants are accepted to ensure that each student is given a minimum of half-hour private lessons per day.

Students are encouraged to participate in the chamber music program, the ultimate environment where students will learn how to practice and perform together, as well as understand the importance of mutual learning and sharing. The groups and the pieces are chosen before the festival starts in order to facilitate immediate collaboration upon arrival. This will allow the students to develop a true musical exchange with one another, which is one of the Academy's main concerns.

Performance opportunities at the end of the festival will allow students to obtain performing experience and apply the skills gathered from their time at the Festival.
